Introduction

Topic

- Society types of Africa (see reference sources)

Materials needed

- Reference sources
- 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 14" white paper
- Markers/colored pencils/ruler

Written letter specifications

- Minimum of 150 words/maximum of 200 words
- Written in friendly letter form
- Written final draft postcard done in pen
- Includes the answers to the study guide questions in your own handwriting

Visual specifications

- Includes a minimum of four pictures on the front (can not use pre-made pictures)
- Pictures must be colored using colored pencils, colors, and/or markers
- Pictures must have captions
- Captions must be written in pen
- Work must tie to the text of the postcard
